Dear Darrin,

I write regarding the power purchase agreement (PPA) between First State Marine Wind, LLC (FSMW) and the Lewes Board of Public Works (BPW), which expires this coming June. I write to suggest we extend the PPA for another five years on identical terms.

This June will mark 11 years since the wind turbine on the University of Delaware's (UD) campus began operation. It has been a fruitful partnership ever since, as Lewes BPW has seamlessly integrated the wind energy into the BPW system, facilitated net metering to the University, and worked with UD on methods of crediting/billing. Certainly, a key component has been our ability to work with you to provide a portion of the electricity generated by the wind turbine to city residents at the BPW's avoided cost. It has been an added bonus that for a number of years, UD and DEMEC have been involved in a partnership that governs the renewable energy credits (RECs) generated by the wind turbine.

We expect that next five years to be equally fulfilling. In that regard, we are pleased to let you know that FSMW has an O&M agreement with the Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy that runs through 2030, so we expect the turbine to maintain its robust and reliable performance going forward.
