BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 07-004

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF LEWES ESTABLISHING NEW WASTEWATER SYSTEM AREA CONNECTION CHARGES (IMPACT FEES) AND SERVICE AREA ZONES

WHEREAS the Board of Public Works exists so that current and future customers have availability and accessibility to safe, reliable and affordable water, electricity, wastewater disposal and other public services; and,

WHEREAS the Board of Public Works provides these services for life sustaining use while being environmental stewards; and

WHEREAS the Board of Public Works anticipates growth that will impact the sanitary sewer system infrastructure and the water reclamation plant treatment capacity; and

WHEREAS the Board of Public Works desires that there must be a reasonable connection between the need for additional facilities and the growth resulting from new development; and

WHEREAS the Board of Public Works desires that there must be a reasonable connection between the expenditure of the fees collected and the benefits received by the development paying the fee; and

WHEREAS the Board of Public Works desires that the fees charged must not exceed a proportionate share of the cost incurred or to be incurred in accommodating the development paying the fee, after crediting that development for other contributions it will make toward the infrastructure cost by other means; and

WHEREAS the staff of the Board of Public Works and its Engineer have conducted an evaluation of the costs of providing infrastructure and capacity to accommodate new growth and have given notice of the proposed new fees; and

WHEREAS the Board of Public Works of the City of Lewes is empowered to impose and collect fees and charges for such purpose.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that The Board of Public Works of the City of Lewes hereby adopts the following IMPACT FEES and the LEWES SANITARY SEWER SERVICE AREA IMPACT ZONES map attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein effective this date; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these impact fees supercede those fees that are inconsistent herewith; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the effective date of these impact fees and impact zones is the date of enactment, August 16, 2007.
