A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF LEWES, ESTABLISHING RATES FOR RESIDENTIAL IRRIGATION METERS

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works exists so that current and future customers have availability and accessibility to safe, reliable and affordable water and other public services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works provides these services for life sustaining use while being environmental stewards; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.4 of the Charter of the Board of Public Works, being Chapter 10, Volume 77, <u>Laws of Delaware</u> as amended, the Board of Public Works has the authority to fix fees for the utility systems; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works desires that there be an effective way for its customers to irrigate and exclude that usage from the calculation of sewer charges.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LEWES BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, IN SESSION MET THIS **30TH** DAY OF **NOVEMBER, 2011**, THAT:

Section 1. The Board of Public Works shall and hereby does establish rates according to exhibit "A" for the existing irrigation system meters and any irrigation system meters installed subsequent to the effective date of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Directors of the Lewes Board of Public Works, and for clarity, shall be applied to the January 1, 2012, and all subsequent billings.
