A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF LEWES, DELAWARE, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS GENERAL MANAGER TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS TO THE ASSET MANAGEMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM THRU THE DNREC FINANCIAL BRANCH FOR CREATING AND MAINTAINING AN ASSET MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.

- WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works exists so that current and future customers have availability and accessibility too safe, reliable and affordable water, electricity, wastewater disposal and other public services; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works provides these services for life sustaining use while being environmental stewards; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works occasionally finds it desirable and in the public interest to explore grants and other funding assistance opportunities to assist with this important responsibility; and
- WHEREAS, funding assistance may be available through the Delaware Office of Drinking Water and the Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control ("DNREC") Water Pollution State Revolving Fund; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works General Manager is only able to apply for such assistance, by the terms of such programs, after the Board of Directors of the Lewes Board of Public Works authorizes such application; and
- WHEREAS, the submission of an application to The Asset Management Incentive Program thru the DNREC Financial Branch, as authorized herein, does not obligate the Board of Public Works to accept any assistance ultimately awarded.
- **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LEWES BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, in session met this 28th DAY OF September, 2016, a quorum pertaining at all times thereto, THAT:
- **Section 1.** The Board of Public Works General Manager is hereby authorized to submit applications to The Asset Management Incentive Program thru the DNREC Financial Branch for assistance related to asset management within all our servicing utilities.
