

REGULAR MEETING Board of Public Works, June 21, 1943

Present: Messrs. Edgar W. Ingram, Cornelius C. Marshall,

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

In order to conserve fuel oil, electric power and water the following resolution was offered and unanimously adopted and motion prevailed that Secretary have 500 copies of this printed and distributed by the men of our Electric Department and run same as an advertisement in the Delaware Coast News during the month of July:-

"Effective at once the use of Automatic Sprinklers is hereby prohibited, and sprinkling the streets, grounds or washing the pavements must be done before eight o'clock in the morning or after six o'clock in the afternoon.

Water Service of users of public water not complying with this Resolution will be discontinued without notice."

Secretary reported that the water pressure on the 8" line supplying the Fort, the Fisheries and the Coast Guard Station was very low when the Fort was drawing water. After discussion motion prevailed that the Secretary be authorized to contact the Area Engineer at Fort Miles and make best possible arrangements for the installation of a booster pump just north of the Coast Guard Station.

Secretary reported that the War Damage Insurance policy in the amount of \$276,290.00 expired on July 1, 1943 and recommended that same be renewed. After a discussion on motion of Edgar W. Ingram and seconded by the Secretary that this Board order War Damage policy in the amount of \$276,290.00 to be renewed, motion carried.

Secretary reported that the Lewes Hosiery Mill Company had paid to the Lewes Trust Company, Trustee, the sum of \$4,425.72 for water and electric current from June 2, 1938 to June 2, 1943 inclusive as per bills rendered each month following terms of Agreement dated June 2, 1938. (Copy of statement of Lewes Trust Company attached).

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the following bills were ordered paid when properly ok'd.
