13	supervision, and control over current or future utility systems established within the Lewes BPW
14	Service Area; and

16 17	WHEREAS, Section 4.6 of the Lewes BPW Charter authorizes Lewes BPW to sell its products and services to public and private persons, firms, associations, corporations, or entities;

20	WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Lewes BPW (the "Board") recognizes the
21	importance of implementing cybersecurity protocols to protect its data from unauthorized access
22	and to safeguard the information of its Board members, employees, and ratepayers.

24	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
25	LEWES BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, IN SESSION MET THIS & DAY OF December,

28	Section 1. Lewes BPW hereby prohibits all of its employees from accepting credit card
29	and bank account information by telephone, email, voicemail, or any other telecommunications
30	technology not expressly authorized as secure for the payment of bills, fees, or other charges
31	related to Lewes BPW services.
32	
33	Section 2. Credit card and bank account information must be processed through a
34	verified Lewes BPW vendor's automated phone system or other Payment Card Industry ("PCI")
35	approved method.
36	
37	Section 3. Lewes BPW employees may verbally discuss the general process of making
38	a payment with customers in order to provide assistance and customer service, but shall not collect
39	sensitive credit card or bank account information. If such information is disclosed, the employee
40	must immediately report such disclosure to his or her supervisor and the IT Manager so that proper
41 42	action can be taken to protect any information that was obtained in violation of this policy.

 Section 4. Any Lewes BPW employee that is found in possession of credit card or bank account data may be subject to disciplinary action, including verbal reprimand, formal written reprimand, suspension without pay, and/or termination.
